Application for the Honor's Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students (Gakushushoreihi)

We accept the application of the Honor's Scholarship. Please submit the application by the date below.

1. Applicants

- Full-time Graduate Students, or Research Students have bachelor degree, Full-time Undergraduate Students, at Josanjima (except for the Faculty of Bioscience and Bioindustry and the Division of Bioresource Science in the Graduate Schools of Sciences and Technology for Innovation)

Note: Students on leave of absence and students who have repeated a year are not eligible.

2. Applicant's Qualification

- The ones whose GPA on the JASSO evaluation scale is more than 2.30 during former fiscal year. Also those can keep 2.30 JASSO evaluation GPA during receiving period. (See "NOTE" for calculation of GPA on the JASSO evaluation scale)
- Applicants who can prove the condition of Language ability (Japanese or English) as below
(Japanese) JLPT N2 or more, EJU Japanese 200 or more, BJT 400 or more
(English) CEFR B2 or more: TOEFL iBT 72 or more, IELTS 5.5 or more, TOEIC L&R 785 or more, other exam to prove English ability (CEFR B2 level)
- Applicants' average monthly remittance from their supporter must be 90,000yen or less.
- Recipients of other scholarships or funds can apply if their scholarship programs or funds allow them to receive JASSO Honors Scholarship.
- Supporter's annual income in Japan must be less than 5,000,000yen.
- Applicants should be able to cooperate with the questionnaire about their course after receiving the scholarship.

Up to 5 students

4. Amount of Scholarship

48,000yen per month

5. Duration of Scholarship

October, 2021 ~ March, 2022

6. Documents to Submit

- A copy of Language Ability Exam Score
- A copy of Yucho bankbook
